

As Davis County Commissioners, we are actively involved with proposed legislation which would affect our county. Some key issues are:

- Property tax adjustments and remedies
- Transportation
- Justice Courts
- Jail reimbursement

In addition, County business in other areas of interest includes:

- Golf Courses: Implementation of new software, EZLink, to enhance tee-time reservations. Reorganization of Valley View Golf Course.
- Events Center: Study by HOK Smith Forkner regarding North Legacy Interchange impact and future use development.
- Facilities: Security and access control installation.
- Information System: Upgrade of MS Windows to Vista
- Public Works: Flood channels
- Personnel: Risk Management and insurance issues.
- Assessors Office: New software for yearly, more accurate, property assessment county-wide.

We regularly dialog and share information with the other elected officials (Sheriff, Clerk/Auditor, Assessor, Treasurer, Attorney, Recorder & Surveyor) relating to county business, budget & tax issues.

A Davis County Trails Committee was newly created to work toward enhancing our existing trails and develop an expanded trail system county wide, a system that connects with neighboring counties to provide more walkable communities.

The Davis County Cabinet for Healthy Families was recently formed. It is comprised of representatives from the Commission Office, Davis School District, Davis Behavioral Health, United Way, Sheriff's Office, Health Department, Dept. of Work Force Services and other organizations. The Cabinet is established to coordinate, and not duplicate, services for our at-risk populations in Davis County.
