REGULAR GENERAL ELECTION
Tuesday, November 3, 2020

I, **Curtis Koch**, Davis County Clerk/Auditor, hereby give notice of the Regular General Election that will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.

As required by SB6007 passed by the Legislature during the 2020 6th Special Session, I provide the following information regarding this election.

To help prevent the spread of the coronavirus, for the 2020 Regular General Election only:

- the election will be conducted primarily by mail;
- in-person voting will be available by limited drive-thru voting please visit www.DavisVotes.com for more information
- drop boxes will be available for depositing mail-in ballots until 8p.m. on election day;
- registration by provisional ballot will be available at any available polling place.

An individual with a disability who is not able to vote a manual (paper) ballot by mail may obtain information on voting in an accessible manner from the county's website, by contacting the county clerk, or by reviewing the information included with the ballot mailed to the voter.

A sample ballot for this election may be obtained from the following sources: www.DavisVotes.com, or the Davis County Clerk's Office - 61 South Main, Farmington. You may also request a copy of the sample ballot by calling 801-451-3589. The sample ballot contains all races and issues for Davis County. Your official ballot will only include races and issues for which you are eligible to vote. Please ask an Election Official for more details.

A public demonstration will be held to test the voting devices and tabulation equipment being used for this Election. Anyone desiring to witness the testing is invited to attend, beginning at 10:00 a.m. October 9, 2020 at the Davis County Administration Building - 61 South Main Street, Room #202 Farmington, UT.

Voters will receive their ballot approximately three weeks prior to Election Day. Drive-up early voting will be available on October 27-30 from 8am-5pm at the Davis County Administration Building. The Polling location will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day for any voter in Davis County to return their ballot. In addition, accessible voting machines will be available at the location listed below.

As required by the Lieutenant Governor's Election Policy, an audit of this election will be conducted on Thursday November 5, 2020 starting at 10:00 a.m. Anyone desiring to witness the audit is invited to attend. The audit will be conducted at the Davis County Administration Building in Room # 202.

Voters must be 18 years old or older by November 3, 2020, citizens of the United States and residents of the voting precinct in which they are voting.
