


Sample Ballot for Davis County, Utah November 5, 2024

To vote for a candidate, completely fill in the oval next to the name(s) of the person(s) you favor as the candidate(s) for each respective office. You do not have to vote in every race.


Go to DavisVotes.Com for candidate information and ballot drop box locations.
