14 years and older <i>Does not consent</i>	N/A	Rape, <i>1st Degree Felony</i> Object Rape, <i>1st Degree Felony</i> Forcible Sodomy, <i>1st Degree Felony</i> Forcible Sexual Abuse, <i>1st Degree Felony</i> Aggravated Sexual Assault, <i>1st Degree Felony</i> (During one of the above crimes or attempts to commit one of those crimes, the offender causes bodily injury, uses or threatens to use a dangerous weapon, threatens imminent death, kidnapping or serious bodily injury to anyone, or is aided or abetted by one or more persons).

1973 to May 9th, 1983	4 years after act	2 years after act	No difference
May 10th, 1983 to April 28th, 1991	4 years after act	2 years after act	1 year after report but within 8 years of the act
April 29th, 1991 to present	4 years after act	2 years after act	4 years after report
