DAVIS COUNTY Ordinance #02-2019-A

SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE OF DAVIS COUNTY ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY LAND USE REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO ALL SUBDIVISIONS IN UNINCORPORATED DAVIS COUNTY.

On February 12, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners of Davis County adopted Ordinance No. 02-2019, which established temporary land use regulations. On March 26, 2019, Ordinance No. 02-2019 was amended to allow one lot subdivisions, located within the unincorporated area of Davis County and on parcels of real property that have not been divided within the last three years, may be accepted, considered, or acted upon by Davis County.

Commissioner Lorene Miner Kamalu voted in favor of / against this Ordinance.

Commissioner Bob J Stevenson voted in favor of / against this Ordinance.

Ordinance #02-2019-A was duly approved and adopted by the County Legislative Body of Davis County, Utah on the 26th day March, 2019 with Commissioners Randy B. Elliott and Bob J Stevenson voting in favor. Commissioner Lorene Miner Kamalu was excused.
