**General Rules:**

- Entries limited to 1 item per department, but individuals may enter multiple departments.
- Items must have been completed within the last 2 years.
- Work previously entered in the Davis County Fair cannot be entered again.
- No unfinished work can be entered & no objects will be accepted for display only.
- Items must be of presentation quality, clean, & not worn.
- Late entries will not be accepted. Baked Goods are the ONLY entries accepted on Tuesday, August 13<sup>th</sup> from noon until 2pm.
- Judges reserve the right to remove or disqualify any entry in violation of the rules, in poor taste, or not in accordance with completion standards.

### Rules & Requirements:

- **Baked Goods are to be entered Tuesday, August 13<sup>th</sup> from noon-2pm.**
- Food items are to be enclosed in plastic bags and items that spoil or become unattractive will be discarded.
- An ingredient list must accompany each entry on a 3x5in index card. Your name should NOT be on it.
- Food entries do not need to be baked from an original recipe, but must be handmade by exhibitor from scratch and not a prepared mix.
- All foods will be tasted and displayed; bring the amount listed for your entry.

## Department C: Canning & Preserves

### Rules & Requirements:

- Canned items are to be entered Saturday, August 10<sup>th</sup> from 10am-2pm
- All canned goods must be labeled as to contents with a NEW 2-piece vacuum seal lid (clear of rust). DO NOT PUT NEW LID/JAR OVER OLD LID/JAR.
- Use clear jars only; colored jars are not acceptable.
- Two (2) jars per entry must be submitted. One jar will be opened and tasted at judging. The other jar will be displayed.
- Preserved food entries must have been prepared within the past year (after June 2018).
- All entries must be home prepared and not commercially canned.
- Canned items which have been opened and judged will not be returned to exhibitors.
