GENERAL RULES:

- This is a 4-H Youth Poultry Show for Davis County residents. Youth enrolled in 4-H ages 5 to 18 are eligible to participate.
- Indicate whether Large Fowl or Bantams.
- Indicate sex whether it is a cock, cockerel, hen or pullet.
 - Cock: a male bird that is over a year old.
 - Cockerel: a male bird under a year old.
 - Hen: a female bird that is over a year old.
 - Pullet: a female bird that is under a year old.
- No sick birds will be allowed.
- There will be 2 main classes. First class, “4-H Poultry Showmanship” is for cloverbuds (youth ages 5 to 8), juniors (ages 8 to 10), intermediates (ages 11-14), seniors (ages 15-18). The second class, “Breed Quality” is where birds will be judged in their cages.
- No exhibitors will be allowed during the judging of the “Breed Quality” class.
- Exhibitors are allowed to enter 2 birds in the show.

Entry Fee: \$2.00 per bird

PREMIUMS:

1st Place: \$2

2nd Place: \$1

3rd Place: Ribbon

Trophies will be given for: best bird of show, champion and reserve hen, champion and reserve rooster, champion and reserve bantam, champion and reserve poultry showmanship (juniors), champion and reserve poultry showmanship (intermediate), champion and reserve showmanship (seniors)

- Birds will be *released* on **Saturday, August 15th at 9:00 pm.**
- Judging will take place the evening of August 11th, 2020.
- Please plan on participating in the 4-H Poultry Showmanship class. 4-H youth ages 5 to 18 are eligible to participate but must be familiar with Poultry Showmanship rules and protocol (contact Jenna Aldrich to get a copy of showmanship rules and protocol).
