#### **GENERAL RULES:**

- This is a 4-H Youth Poultry Show for Davis County residents. Youth enrolled in 4-H ages 5 to 18 are eligible to participate.
- Indicate whether Large Fowl or Bantams.
- Indicate sex whether it is a cock, cockerel, hen or pullet.
  - o Cock: a male bird that is over a year old.
  - o Cockerel: a male bird under a year old.
  - o Hen: a female bird that is over a year old.
  - o Pullet: a female bird that is under a year old.
- No sick birds will be allowed.
- There will be 2 main classes. First class, "4-H Poultry Showmanship" is for cloverbuds (youth ages 5 to 8), juniors (ages 8 to 10), intermediates (ages 11-14), seniors (ages 15-18). The second class, "Breed Quality" is where birds will be judged in their cages.
- No exhibitors will be allowed during the judging of the "Breed Quality" class.
- Exhibitors are allowed to enter 2 birds in the show.
