



Description: The Mueller Park Trail epitomizes the metro-to-mountains convenience of living in the Great Salt Lake Valley at the foot of the Wasatch Range. Within minutes, literally, the nearby suburban jungle is transformed to a tranquil, backcountry ecosystem of lush riparian growth mixed with hardwoods and conifers. The valley's droning clamor is replaced by spirited sounds of nature, and the odor of urbanization succumbs to the wood's deep, earthy bouquet. Through breaks in the forest's cover are good views of the Great Salt Lake and the metropolitan valley. Quick access to the trail, instant submersion in nature, and distant views of the metro you left behind are several reasons why mountain bikers cherish the Mueller Park Trail. Oh, it's one of the best singletracks around, too. Tread: Dirt and rock singletrack throughout.

Trailhead Location: From I-15, take the Woods Cross exit. Go east on 2600 South, 0.9 miles north on Orchard Drive, 1 mile east on 1800 South, then 2 miles to entrance. Group picnic area is 100 yards east of locked gate at the east end of park.

Length: 13 miles
Time: 3 to 4 hours up and back
Elevation Rise: 1,910 ft.
Use: hike, bike, equestrian, motorized
