


Location View

Description: This is a beautiful hiking trail with some steep sections. The trail follows a natural “subway” up the ridge toward the cliffs. The Hornet Canyon Trail branches off just before reaching Hornet Creek. Take the right fork to stay on the Steed Creek Trail. You will pass several large white rocks. Keep these to your right until you can see all of Steed Canyon. Ascend the ridge with Steed Canyon just to your right until the trail seems to end on a promontory. Turn straight left for 30 feet and you will see the start of Subway. The trail passes through a mountainside forest in a fairly level area at the base of the majestic cliffs. The trail continues up the mountain more than half way up the mountain. You will be high on a ridge overlooking the canyon and valley. It is an incredible view!

 **Trailhead Location:** The end of the pavement on 200 East in Farmington.

Length: 4.1 miles
 Time: 3 to 5 hours up and back
 Elevation Rise: 1400 ft.
 Use: hike
