Providers have been claiming their programs and learning to use the platform so they'll be ready to smoothly and efficiently connect people with the resources and services they need.

Highlights of the first 5 months:



Training & Support for Providers

- Delivered a series of 6 trainings on how to use the Davis Links Resource Directory provider site to a combined 239 participants
- Released a Davis Links Resource Directory Provider Welcome Kit
- Provided technical support to providers, responding to 20+ requests

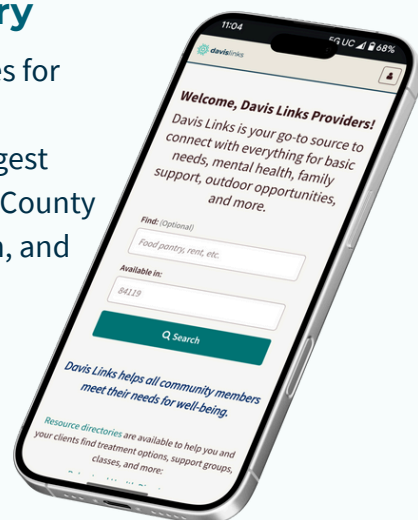
Website & Branding Updates

- Worked on designing and developing the multi-site web presence for Davis Links supporting both provider and public-facing tools

Expanding the Resource Directory

- Identified 1,400+ local programs and services for the Davis Links Resource Directory
- Added programs offered by the county's largest health and human services providers: Davis County Health Department, Davis Behavioral Health, and Utah Department of Workforce Services
- Worked on troubleshooting with Findhelp to resolve technical issues
- Began using the Program Manager Tool to directly add more programs and services

Organizations like Assisting Hands, Cars that Care, Children's Service Society of Utah, Midtown Community Health Center, Open Doors, People Helping People, and more have taken the lead on getting their programs added, claimed, and updated in the Davis Links Resource Directory.



The Davis Links Resource Directory currently includes **907** national programs, **1,051** state programs, and **126** local programs. Of those, about **30%** of national and state programs are claimed, and **44%** of local programs are claimed.

In the first 5 months, **121 providers signed up for a Davis Links provider account** and **1,356 actions were taken to manage a program** on Davis Links.

The Davis Links Resource Directory is only as strong as the community behind it. As it continues to grow, our focus is on sustainability, community engagement, and public awareness. By working together to add, claim, and update programs, we can build a lasting tool that strengthens resource connection across Davis County.
