- Ways of describing attributes of a person that could help them find programs they are looking for such as veterans, disability, or older adults

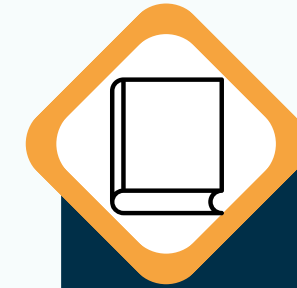

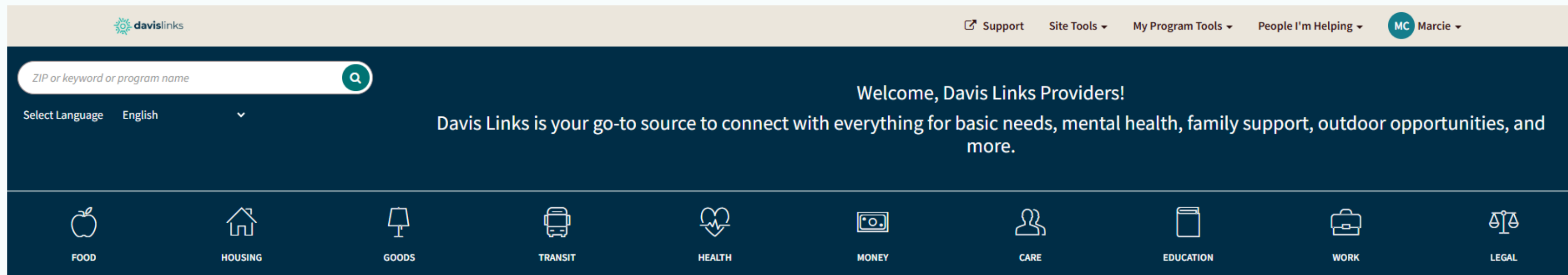

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Main Services Tags

Tags can be selected for main services and secondary services an organization provides.

- **Main services:** primary services that someone might enroll in a program to receive
- **Secondary services:** any other services besides the main services (not taken into account in a search)

What are the main services you provide?* 

These are the primary services that someone might enroll in your program to receive. For example, imagine a job-skills program that provides a free lunch. Skills & Training is their primary service, meals are not. See [more details](#) about primary vs secondary services.


What secondary services do you provide?

Main Services Tags

Use general tags since seeker can get specifics from description or organization website.

These are the primary services that someone might use to find your organization. Distinguish between primary vs secondary services.

Tag Hierarchy: Parent/Child

There are different levels of service tags.


Parent: broad category

Child: tags underneath the broad category

- *Mental Health Care* (parent)
 - *Anger Management* (child)
 - *Bereavement* (child)
 - *Counseling* (child)

If you search for a child tag, you will only see programs with that tag. However, if you search for the broader parent tag, the search results will show programs with the parent tag, as well as any programs that have the child tags.


