The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chief Eric Froerer.

## Welcome

Chief Froerer welcomed council members, staff and visitors to the meeting.

## Minutes (Action)

The minutes of the February 6, 2014 meeting were presented and reviewed.

*Dr. Feil motioned to accept minutes of the February 6, 2014 meeting minutes. Dr. Swiler seconded. The vote was unanimous.*

## Report of State Protocol Review Task Force (Action)

Task force members reviewed the four new state categories and recommended the council adopt the new protocols with minor amendments in two sections. Chief Smith recommended scheduling a role out date so all agencies can prepare and implement training in preparation. Amendments to the sections will be completed by Mr. Cook and forwarded to the Health Department for compilation and distribution.

*Chief Smith motioned to adopt the new state protocols with the identified amendments with an implementation date of July 1, 2014. Dr. Oraskovich seconded. The vote was unanimous.*

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### **RSI Update (Information)**

Dr. Oraskovich reported that the presentation to the Committee regarding a second pilot project was successful. Primary Children's Hospital has responded to a request regarding lowering the age of those eligible in the program. Their opinion was to lower the eligible age group to 8 and above. The second pilot project will begin June 1, 2014 and run for two years. The new project will include age groups 8 and up as well as two new medications Rocuronium and Ketamine. New training addressing pediatric patients will begin in May 2014.

Adult RSI was approved for a permanent variance for Layton and the Davis County Sheriff's Office.
