17th Annual Antelope by Moonlight Bike Ride,

“Moonlight Bites”



This is a popular, family friendly, non-competitive bike ride at Antelope Island State Park, in the middle of Great Salt Lake. The ride starts at 10:00 PM and is lit by the full moon. The 22 mile route goes from the Marina to the historic Fielding Garr Ranch and back. Registration covers park entry, a collector's t-shirt, and refreshments (served until midnight). Late Registration:

Age over 14: \$27.00 after June 11, 2010

14 and under: \$22.00 after June 11, 2010

Age determination:

14 and under as of June 25, 2010

Check in and on site registration: 7:30 – 10 pm

Utah State law requires all night riders to use a working headlight and reflectors. Helmets are mandatory also. Lights and helmets will be available for sale at the ride.

Prizes will be given for the best decorated bike using the ride theme. Judging will be at 9:30 pm at the Marina.
