H1N1 Vaccination Clinics FREE to EVERYONE

(Farmington, Utah) – The Davis County Health Department has **free** H1N1 vaccines available for the **general public**. Everyone is encouraged to receive an H1N1 vaccine.

The H1N1 virus is still in our communities. Vaccination remains the best way to prevent getting the H1N1 virus. Stay healthy. Get vaccinated.

Walk-ins are welcome for these free H1N1 vaccination clinics.

New H1N1 vaccination clinic days, times, and locations:

- **Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays – 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m.:** *Clearfield Immunization Clinic* – 140 East Center Street (2nd floor of Heritage Senior Activity Center), Clearfield. *(Walk-ins are welcome.)*
- **Tuesdays, Thursdays – 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m.:** *Bountiful/Woods Cross Immunization Clinic* – 596 West 750 South, Woods Cross. *(Walk-ins are welcome.)*
- **Saturday, Feb. 6 – 10 a.m.-7 p.m.:** *Layton Hills Mall center court* – 1076 Layton Hills Mall, Layton. *(Walk-ins are welcome.)*

Please wear a short-sleeved shirt under your coat to speed your vaccination process.

Parents and caregivers are reminded that the second dose of the H1N1 vaccine is due for children 6 months to under 10 years of age who were first vaccinated at least 28 days prior.
