Competition Rules

Entry/Eligibility:

1. Everyone who is interested must fill out an entry form and submit it to the Legacy Events Center Office by August 11th, 2010. From these applicants, members of the Davis County Fair Board will choose who gets to perform at the 1st round. Applicants who have been chosen to perform will be notified by Wednesday, August 11th or sooner.
2. Contestants must be non-professional entertainers. Professional entertainers include:
 - a. One who earns more than 1/2 of his or her normal living expenses by performing the specified talent for this competition, or
 - b. One who is a union member, or
 - c. One who has a professional agent or manager who is or will be paid a fee for securing employment in the entertainment field, or
 - d. One who sings or otherwise performs on any record released for commercial distribution through normal retail outlets (this does not prohibit an entertainer from self-producing a record for sale or distribution to friends and associates, or performing on a self-produced recording of a school or church choir group for charitable fundraising purposes).
3. Performer must be able to attend both rounds of Davis County's Got Talent. The first round will be on **Wednesday, August 18th from 6:00pm to 7:45pm**. The final round will be on **Saturday, August 21st from 7:00pm to 7:45pm**.
4. Contestants of all ages are welcome! No age restrictions.
5. Contestants who participated in the 2009 Davis County's Got Talent are welcome to apply.

Performance:

6. Auditions may be held, depending on the number of applicants we receive.
7. Contestants should arrive 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the show and must check in at the main stage.
8. The time limit for 1st round is 2 minutes or less for each performer's presentation, from beginning to end. The time limit for the final round is 4 minutes or less for each performer's presentation, from beginning to end.
9. Talents must not involve fire, smoke, smoke effect or anything that could be considered a weapon.
10. Performances must be appropriate for all ages. Davis County reserves the right to immediately stop any performance that its representatives or the judges deem unsuitable, offensive or inappropriate.
11. Appropriate attire must be worn throughout the performance. Clothing must not be revealing or have inappropriate language, graphics or symbols on it.
12. If using music, contestants must bring this music on an mp3 player. All music should be cued and ready to start.
13. Sound system and microphones will be provided by the Davis County Fair.
14. Photography and videotaping are allowed.

Judging:

15. Monetary prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners: 1st place: \$100; 2nd place: \$50; 3rd place: \$25.
16. Our judging panel will consist of 4 judges. The 5 contestants who will be moving on from the first round will be chosen solely by the 4 judges. These contestants will be announced at the end of the show. For the final round, votes will be cast by the 4 judges, and the fifth judge will be the audience. Their cheers will be measured by a decibel counter.
 - a. Contestants will be judged on quality of performance (talent), stage presence, and entertainment value.
 - b. The judge's decisions are final.
