

## **Plans Review (Davis County Pool Regulations, section 8)**

### *Regulations for the Design, Construction and Operation of Public Pools*

“In order to assure construction of safe and sanitary public pools the following requirements on design detail and structural stability shall apply:

1. Plans and specifications for a public pool must be reviewed by a licensed architect or engineer and certified as to compliance with this regulation and other applicable law.
2. Plans and specifications for a public pool must be submitted to the Division (Environmental Health Services) for review and approval prior to construction of a public pool.
  - a. Public pools shall be constructed according to the approved plans and specifications. All changes to the approved plans and specifications must be approved by the Division.
  - b. The Division assumes no responsibility for mistakes or omissions by the certifying architect or engineer.
3. The shape of a pool and design and location of appurtenances must be such that the circulation of pool water and control of swimmer’s safety is not impaired.
4. Where a facility is subject to freezing temperatures, all parts of the facility must be adequately and properly protected through design accommodations.”
