Wandcraft

Create the magic wand of your dreams!



Supplies needed:

Chopsticks

Paper

Markers

Glue

Decorating supplies such as ribbon, colored tape, glitter glue, paint, etc.

A single chopstick makes a great wand! You can decorate it with paint or markers, or leave it as is. You may want to add an exciting topper, like a moon, sun, lightning bolt, etc. Cut these out of paper and glue or tape to the top of the wand. (Consider taping 2 back to back with the wand top inside so that the tape is covered. You could also add streamers or ribbon to trail from the wand, or you could wrap it around the bottom as a handle. You can decorate the wand and its top even more with markers, glitter, etc. Then poof! You'll have a magic wand!

Divination



Instead of using a crystal ball to see the future, use crystals to see rainbows in your own home!

Get a small crystal prism or an old CD. Stand by a window and reflect the crystal or CD so the light bounces off it and onto a wall (you could also use a piece of white paper to catch this). Play with different angles and ways to see the rainbows! You could also do this by putting a mirror in water and then angling it to reflect a rainbow onto a white paper. You could even spray water from a spray bottle into the light from a window and see the colors in the droplets!

Astronomy



Check out a book on constellations from your library and look for some at night! The library also has telescopes you can check out—ask a librarian for details. You can even make your own constellation: take a piece of black paper and draw stars on it in white crayon. Connect them to make a picture with your stars!
