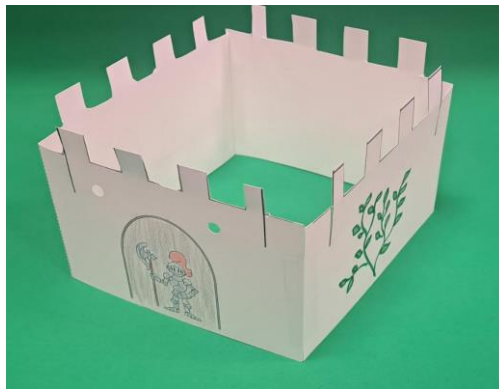


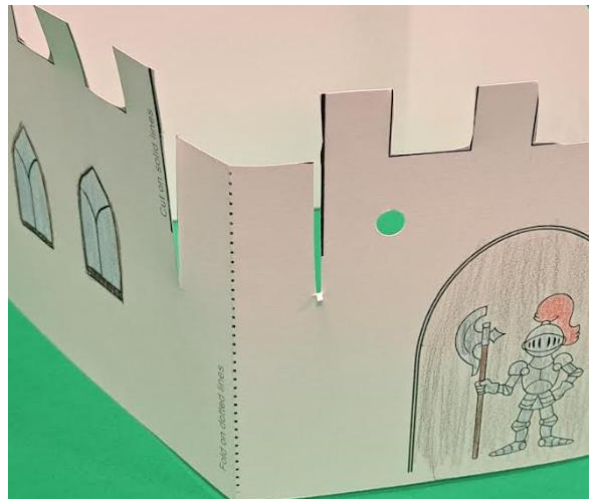
Castle Instructions

1. Cut the template in half lengthwise, along the solid line.
Cut out the shaded boxes.
Don't cut out the doorway!
Use a hole punch to make 2 holes above the doorway, on the circles on the template.
2. Decorate the castle walls.
Fold each piece along the dotted lines, and tape the pieces together into a box shape.

3. Decorate 2 toilet paper tubes. Cut slits that are about 1.25" inches apart, and half the length of the tube.
4. Cut slits on the front corners of the castle, on the solid lines



5. Slide the towers onto the front corners. You may have to make the slits on the toilet paper tubes a bit wider or long to make them fit.



6. Use a rectangle of paper (3" x 2.5") for a drawbridge. Tape it to the bottom edge of the castle, under the doorway. We used blue tape for the example, but clear tape is recommended for your project.



7. Thread an 11" piece of yarn through the holes above the doorway, with the ends coming out of the front. Tape each end to the corner of the drawbridge that is farthest from the castle. Now you can pull the yarn from the inside to raise the drawbridge.
