APPETITE

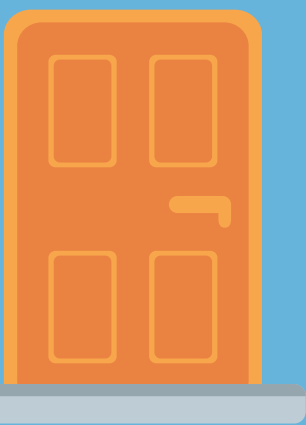
Cats depend on smell when it's eating time, so sometimes when they're stuffed up they are less inclined to eat. Warming up their food can help them smell it better!

KEEP 'EM SEPARATED

Upper Respiratory Infections (URIs) are contagious, and can be passed from cat to cat. Dogs need not worry, though!

MEDICATIONS

Your cat's medication is critical to their recovery! Make sure they are getting their prescribed dosage every day. If you have trouble, mixing the dosage into some tasty wet food can help make the process smooth.

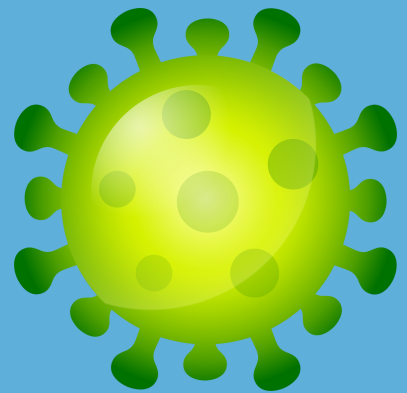
KENNEL COUGH

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT TAKING HOME A DOG WITH A COLD!

WHAT IS IT?

Canine infectious tracheobronchitis is an airborne virus that is common in kennel situations. The virus causes the trachea to become inflamed.

EXERCISE

Your pup's cough can be aggravated by extracurricular activities. Keep the playtime to a minimum if you notice that they start to have a coughing fit.

Kennel cough is contagious, and can be passed from dog to dog. We don't recommend visiting dog parks or vet clinics during this time. Cats need not worry, though!
