Our Year in Review

Highlights of the Year – Davis County Library connected its patrons to a blend of new and expanded services while continuing to offer traditional library services and resources to the citizens of Davis County. The Library moved from the state's OverDrive consortium to managing its own OverDrive account, providing the opportunity to be more responsive to the requests of our patrons. In order to meet ever increasing interest in this collection, the budget for digital items was increased. As a result, downloadable digital materials purchased by Davis County in 2016 doubled the number purchased in 2015. Materials continue to be purchased regularly to enhance and improve the library's digital offerings.

The library requested a tax increase, which was approved, making way for three major capital projects that will provide access to improved library service for the citizens of the county. Plans for the expansion of the Syracuse/Northwest Branch and discussions surrounding the future of the South Branch in Bountiful and the North Branch in Clearfield are underway.

Programs – Featured programs, designed for patrons of all ages, included a gardening workshop focusing on xeriscaping options, a portrait photography workshop, and a "how to use" session for new electronic gadgets. Bestselling author Kenneth Oppel visited in May while actor and voice artist Kirby Heyborne appeared in September. Library patrons were *Lost In Time* at the Library during annual read-a-thon activities and *Babysitting Bootcamp* prepared the attending recruits for future babysitting jobs. *On Your Mark, Get Set, Read* was the theme for the six week summer reading program while *Spooktacular* stories were offered to one and all in the fall.

By the Numbers – Over 169,000 library card holders borrowed over 2.76 million items in 2016. Over 543,000 users accessed 5.27 million pages on our website and online catalog. The number of digital titles downloaded was 265,946, another significant increase of 52% from last year. Public Internet access continues to be well-used with 394,642 sessions on library PCs and 729,779 sessions on the library's wireless network.
