- December

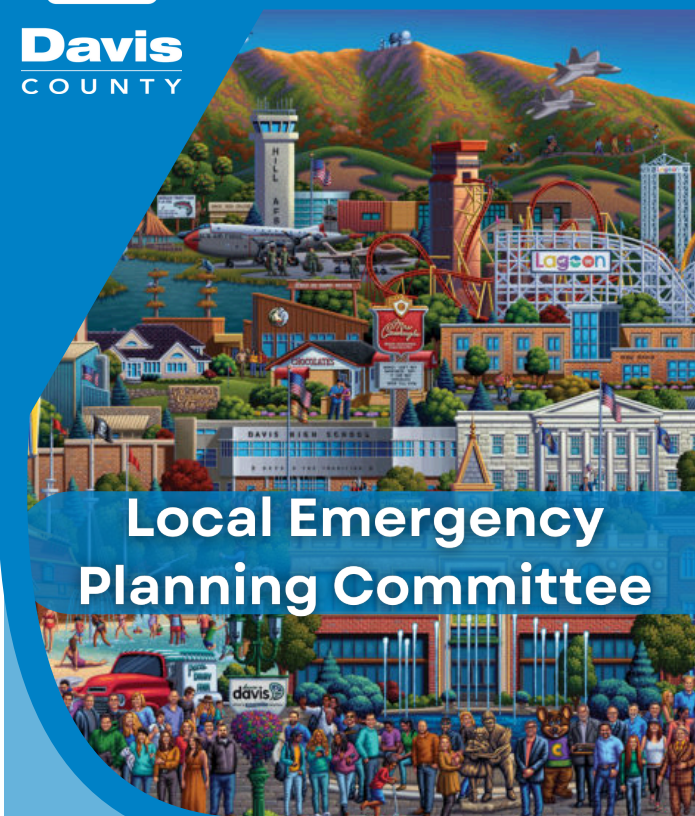

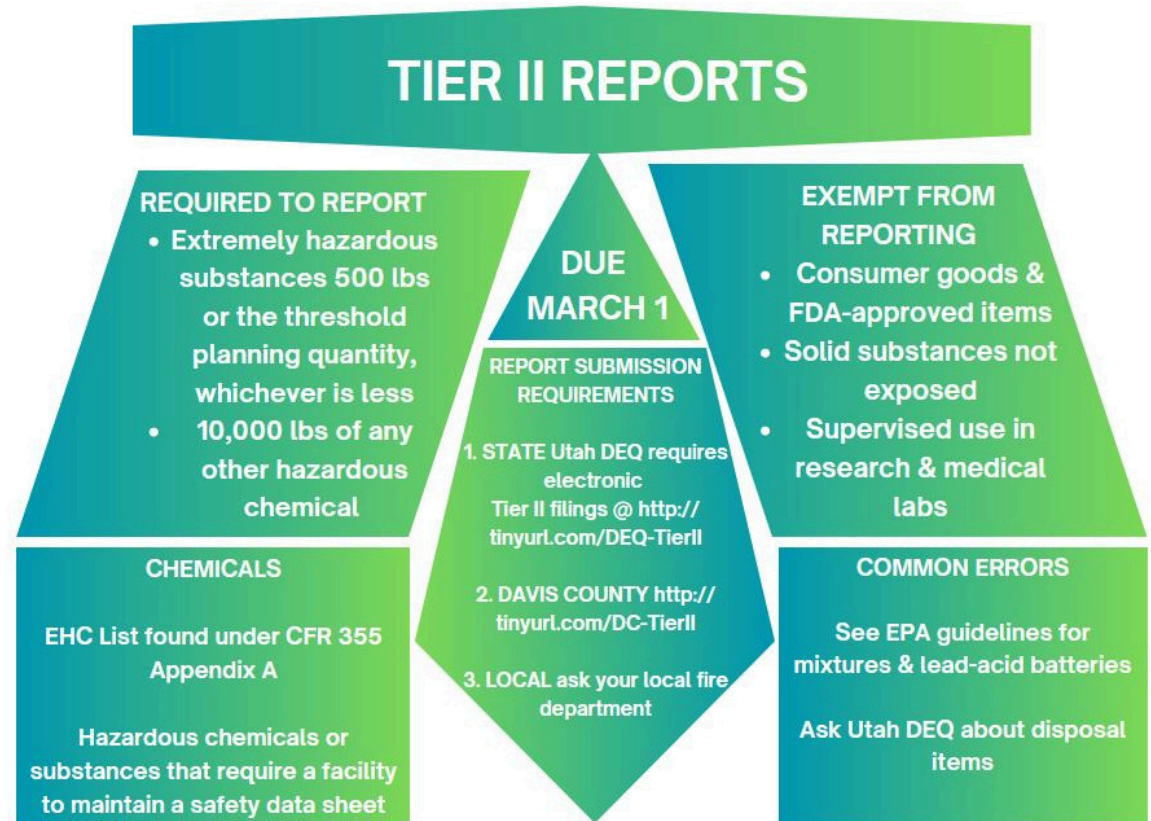


Who Should Attend LEPC Meetings?
