Quick Links

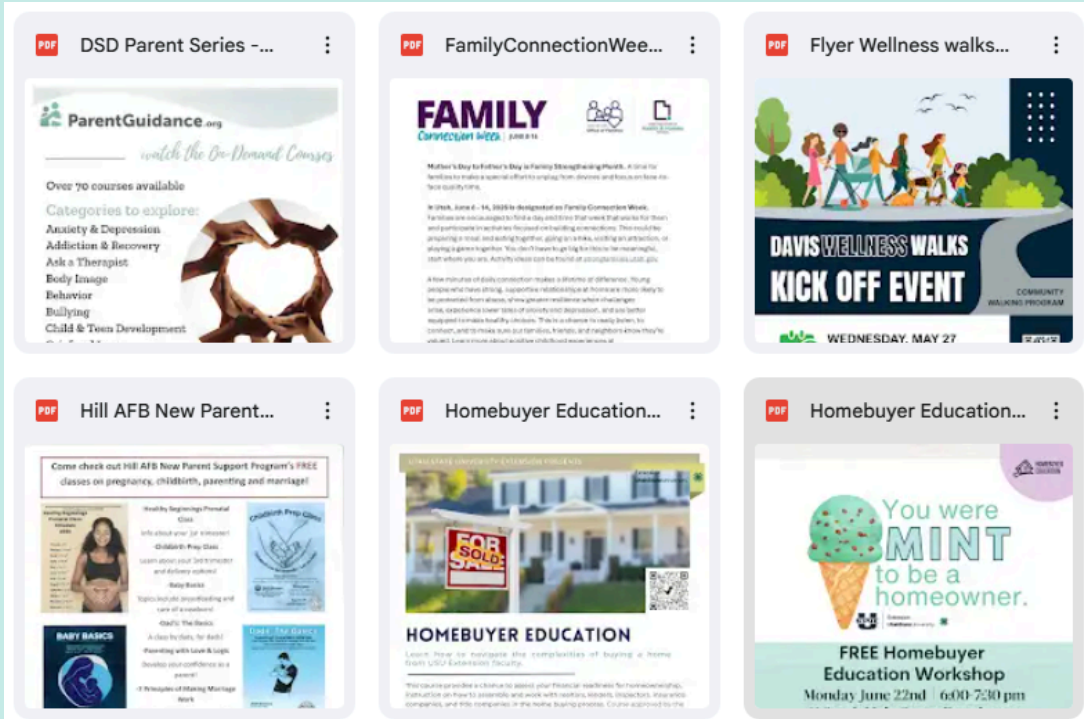

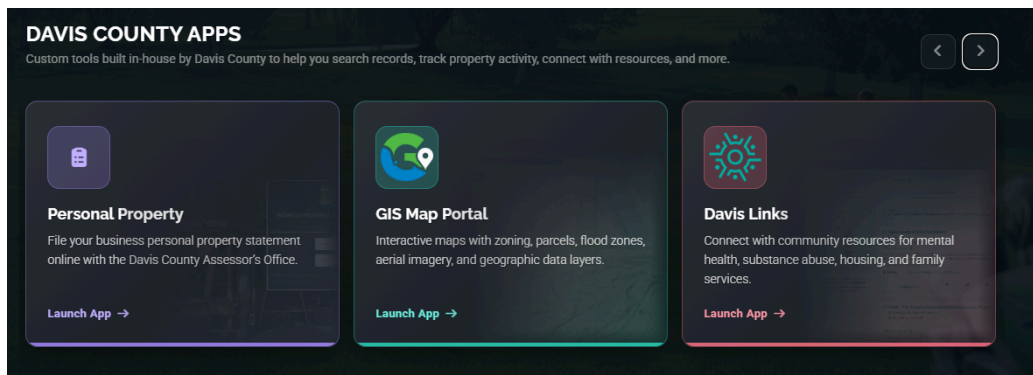
