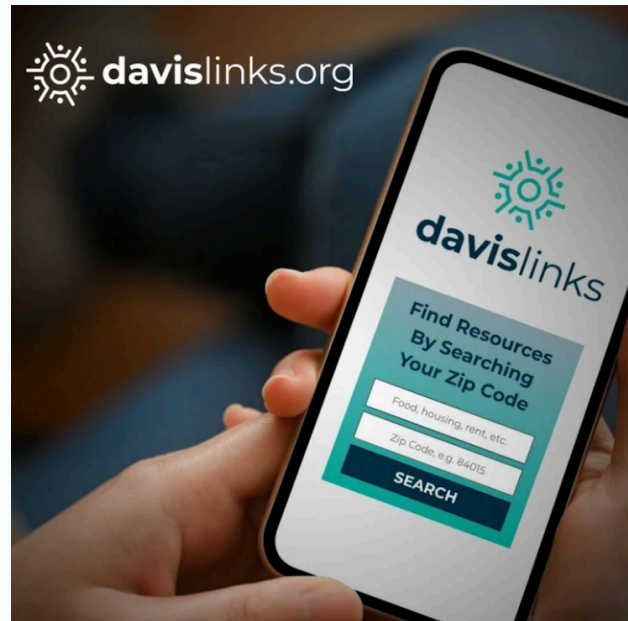

Searching in Davis Links

To search the resource directory, a topic and ZIP code is entered. Once the resource directory opens, there are ten main categories at the top of the page. Each of the main categories have subcategories to help you find the resource you are looking for.

If you are searching for a resource in the resource directory and not finding it, contact the support team. The support team will look into adding it to the directory. Or you can add the program by using the Suggest Program option on the resource directory home page.

Tagging Program Cards

Tagging the appropriate serve and people tags allows community members to find your program when they search the directory. For more information on how to navigate Findhelp's taxonomy, refer to the [Taxonomy and Tags information](#).

Tip: In the people tags, there are tags for community members who are undocumented, immigrants, or refugees. This is found in the Citizenship category. If your program serves this population, please check that tag to ensure your program reaches the intended population.
