#### **Older Americans Month: May 2024**

May is the month to recognize the accomplishments and contributions of older Americans, to accept our own aging process, and reinforce our dedication to valuing our life experiences and those of others.

When Older Americans Month was established in 1963, only 17 million living Americans had reached their 65th birthday. About a third of older Americans lived in poverty and there were few programs to meet their needs. Interest in older Americans and their concerns was growing. A meeting in April 1963 between President John F. Kennedy and members of the National Council of Senior Citizens led to designating May as "Senior Citizens Month," the prelude to "Older Americans Month." Historically, Older Americans Month has been a time to acknowledge the contributions of past and current older persons, in particular those who defended our country. Every President since Kennedy has issued a formal proclamation during or before the month of May asking that the entire nation pay tribute in some way to older persons in their communities.

Older Americans Month is celebrated across the country through ceremonies, events, fairs, and other such activities. Every year, Older Americans Month introduces a new theme, ranging from "Older Americans and the Family" in 1978 to "Aging Unbound" in 2023. The theme for 2024 is "Powered by Connection," emphasizing the profound impact of meaningful relationships and social connections on our health and general welfare.

This May join us in advocating the advantages of building connections with others. Here are some ways you can get involved.

- Share facts about the mental, physical, and emotional health benefits of social connection and how it contributes to overall well-being.
- Promote resources that help older adults engage, like community events, social clubs, senior activity centers and volunteer opportunities.
- Share what connection means to you on social media using the hashtag #PoweredByConnection.





#### LIS: Low Income Subsidy

A federal program that helps pay for Medicare Prescription drug coverage. You may be eligible for help if you are single and your monthly income is less than \$1,822 or if you are married and your combined monthly income is less than \$2,465.
