## What to Bring:

- Proof of identification (photo ID)
- Social Security cards or Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITIN) for you, your spouse, and/or dependents
- Proof of foreign status, if applying for an ITIN
- Birth dates for all on the tax return
- For married filing joint, both spouses must be present
- All Forms W-2, W-2G, 1099 and 1098
- A copy of last year's federal and state returns
- Proof of bank account and routing information if choosing direct deposit of refund (e.g. voided check)
- Total paid to daycare provider and their tax ID
- Health insurance exemption certificate, if received
- All Forms 1095 Health Insurance statements
  The 1095A Health Insurance Form from the marketplace

To Qualify: Household income under

\$70,000

## One-on-one Tax Return Preparation Services (VITA/TCE)

Each year, the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) and the Tax Counseling for the Elderly (TCE) programs offer free, face-to-face tax help to people with low-to-moderate income.
